RECOMMENDED BREEDING PRACTICES OF THE GSDC OF SA INC.

Amended April 2008 – Effective 1st. May 2008.

Mandatory conditions marked with *

1. Overview

- a) Broadly speaking, animals can be divided into two categories for breeding value:
 - i) those suitable for breeding; and
 - ii) those unsuitable for breeding.
Included in the latter group are those animals which are afflicted with diseases or deficiencies which make them undesirable in the sense of planned breeding. These are mainly animals with temperament deficiencies (fear-biters, nervous, shy or overly-aggressive animals), or those having testicle deficiencies, extremely long hair without undercoat, deformed or floppy ears, serious tail faults (hooked, curled or rolled up tails) or deformity of any kind. Also included are those dogs severely affected by dysplastic condition of the hip and elbow joints, white coloured dogs and blues or browns.
- b) As breed improvement can only be obtained by selective breeding, the better animals of those categorised as suitable for breeding are those which will contribute to breed surveys (see special rules). Breed Survey Class 1 dogs and bitches are those which are anatomically far above the average and, as such, are highly recommended for breed improvement. Breed Survey Class II dogs and bitches are those which are above the average and, as such, are suitable for breed improvement.
- c) Those animals that fail to gain breed survey classification, are animals obviously unsuitable for breeding, and should not be used. It is therefore recommended that only dogs and bitches successfully gaining Breed Survey Class I or II be used for breeding.

2. * Operation of the Puppy Listing Scheme

For a litter to be eligible for inclusion in the puppy listing scheme, both parents must have successfully gained Breed Survey Class 1 or Class 11 and have the 'A' and 'Z' stamps for Hips and Elbows. A fee, as determined by the Committee, will entitle litters to be placed on the puppy listings, listed in the Shepherd News and the Web page. Once the litter is sold the Breeder is required to advise the Puppy Listing Officer.

Breed surveyors shall be responsible for inspecting foster-mothers and kennel conditions.

Breeders must submit the following declaration to the club secretary: "I/we declare that the above litter has been bred in accordance with the Recommended Breeding Practices of the GSDC of SA Inc and I/we also declare that I/we have no non-recommended litters planned (within sixteen (16) weeks from the date of whelping of my current listed litter) or on my/our premises or in my/our Kennel name.

I/we will notify the puppy listing officer as soon as any contagious or infectious disease is diagnosed in my/our Kennel, at which time the puppies will be removed from the Puppy Listing and will be reinstated when a letter is received from a Veterinarian, stating that any infection is no longer contagious."

3. * Hip & Elbow X-Rays

Hip Dysplasia

As an x-ray is the only sure way of determining whether an animal is affected with a dysplastic condition of the hip joints, all breeding stock should be x-rayed and x-rays submitted through the National GSDC of A HD Scheme for assessment.

*** Elbow Dysplasia**

As an x-ray is the only sure way of determining whether an animal is affected with a genetic or arthritic condition of the elbow joints, all breeding stock should be x-rayed and x-rays submitted through the National GSDC of A Elbow Scheme for assessment.

4*. Minimum Age for Breeding

After many years' experience it has been found that animals should not be used for breeding before attaining their full development. When first used for breeding, bitches shall be a minimum of eighteen (18) months of age at mating and Breed Surveyed and stud dogs shall be a minimum of eighteen months of age at mating and Breed Surveyed.

5. * Frequency of Breeding

A strong and healthy bitch may be mated on consecutive seasons with the following provisions.

- a) No more than twelve puppies shall be kept from two consecutive litters from a bitch mated on consecutive seasons.
- b) If six or less puppies from the first litter are reared by the bitch, then the bitch may be mated on her next season. If more than six puppies from the first litter are reared by the bitch, under no circumstances shall she be mated on her next season.
- c) A bitch which has been mated on consecutive seasons shall be rested on the third.

Irrespective of the frequency of a bitch's seasons, she shall not have more than three litters in any twenty-four month period.

6. * Number of Puppies in a Litter

No Restriction on litter size, however, more than 8 puppies must be supplemented with bottle feeding or the use of a Foster Mother.

7. * Use of a Foster-Mother

- a) Where there are more than eight puppies in a litter, a foster-mother may be used to wet-nurse additional puppies. The foster-mother must be strong, healthy, of good character and be at least forty-five centimetres in height at the withers.
- b) Puppies which have been accepted by the foster-mother shall be left with her until they are at least five weeks of age. The age difference between the foster-mother's puppies and the fostered puppies shall be no greater than two weeks.
- c) The deliberate breeding of a bitch to be used as a foster-mother, and with the intention of destroying the resultant litter, is prohibited. If a foster-mother is used, the breeder must notify the Breed Affairs Chairperson within forty-eight hours and submit written notification to the Club within ten days of whelping.

8. * Culling of Puppies

Culling of puppies shall be done by a Veterinarian. Where puppies need to be culled, a veterinary certificate shall be provided.

9. * Rearing of the Litter

- a) If dew claws are present on the hind legs they must be properly removed within a week of birth by a Veterinarian, as this is the only time it can be done without tormenting the puppy.
- b) The breeder must ensure that there are neither external nor internal parasites present in the puppies.
- c) Puppies shall be vaccinated against distemper, hepatitis and parvovirus prior to tattooing.
- d) Puppies reared by their natural mother shall be left with her until they are at least five weeks of age.

10. * Tattooing

All puppies bred in accordance with the Recommended Breeding Practices shall be tattooed in accordance with the rules and regulations of the National Tattoo Scheme.

To participate the litter must be registered with the SACA, all whelps in the litter must be tattooed, and tattooing will be carried out between seven (7) and eight (8) weeks of age.

The tattoo is to be placed in the right ear, comprising of 3 alpha and 3 numerals, which is to be allocated by the National Council Tattoo Registrar, and the appropriate form can be obtained from the Breed Affairs Chairperson upon request. The form accompanied by the prescribed fee is to be forwarded to the National Council Tattoo Registrar.

The Breeder must notify the Tattoo officer "AS SOON AS ANY CONTAGIOUS OR INFECTIOUS DISEASE IS DIAGNOSED IN THEIR KENNEL."

The Breeder is required to make the vaccination certificates available for the tattoo officer to inspect.

The tattoo officer may require an inspection of the Kennel conditions.

11. * Age of Puppies at Sale

Puppies shall not leave the kennel until they are at least eight weeks of age, and then only if there are no contagious diseases in the kennel and the litter has been tattooed.

12. * Penalties for False Declarations

Where a breeder has made a false declaration on a Litter Notification Form, the breeder and the kennel shall be penalised as follows: -

First offence - twelve months denial from the puppy listings.

Second offence - twenty-four months, denial from the puppy listings.

Third offence - banned for life from the puppy listings.

13. Advertising in Breeders Directory

Penalty for signing a Breeders Directory application form and not abiding by the Recommended Breeding Practices will result in the Kennel advertisement being removed from the Web Page and Shepherd News for a period of 12 months from the date of the birth of the litter after which a new application can be lodged. However, if there is a subsequent breach the matter will be dealt with by Committee.

ABBREVIATED MANDATORY CONDITIONS APPLYING TO THE RECOMMENDED BREEDING PRACTICES

- 1 (d) Both parents must have gained Breed Survey Classification, and an 'A' or 'a' Stamp for Hips and 'Z' Stamp for elbows.
- 1 (e) I/we declare that the above litter has been bred in accordance with the Recommended Breeding Practices of the GSDC of SA Inc, and I/we also declare that I/we have no non-recommendable litters on my/our premises or in my/our Kennel name.
- 3 The minimum age for breeding animals shall be eighteen month (18) months for bitches at mating, and eighteen (18) months for dogs at mating and all animals must be Breed survey at the time of whelping (bitches) and dogs (at mating).
- 7 Where puppies need to be euthanased, a Veterinary certificate shall be provided.
- 8 Puppies shall be inoculated against Distemper/Hepatitis/Parvo Virus prior to Tattooing.
- 9 All puppies shall be tattooed in accordance with the National Tattoo Scheme.
- 10 Puppies shall not be sold and leave the Kennel until eight (8) weeks of age.
