SNAKE BITES

We are now in the dreaded 'snake' season and need to keep a good look out for snakes. Some snakes can kill dogs in a few short minutes whilst others can take a couple of hours.

For this year the following snake bite statistics have been recorded:

The response of 106 veterinary surgeons revealed that snake bite in domestic animals is frequent, with an estimated 6200 cases reported annually. Bites were more prominent in rural (78%) than urban areas (22%) with brown, tiger and black snakes accounting for 76%, 13% and 6% of cases, respectively. Cats and dogs were the most frequently reported victims. Ninety-one percent of cats and 75% of dogs survived following the administration of antivenom whereas 66% of cats and 31% of dogs survived without antivenom. Overall, in 33% of cases antivenom was not used, and venom detection kits were used in only 1% of cases.

BROWN SNAKE BITES IN DOGS

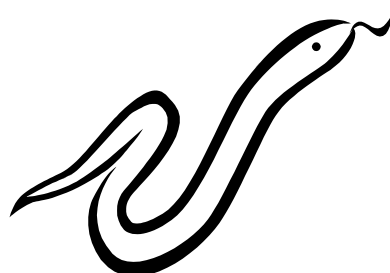
Brown Snake symptoms are slow in onset and include a progressive paralysis beginning at the back legs and extending forward. In the early stages, eyes can be rolling and muscles spasms occur. Eventually paralysis becomes total with a lolling of the tongue, non-responsive pupils and laboured breathing. Often vomiting occurs within a few minutes as the toxin causes the muscles to spasm. Deceased dogs are often found with vomit beside them or around them.

TIGER SNAKE BITES IN DOGS

Dogs bitten by this species become very agitated immediately after and display hyper-activity for a brief period before collapsing in an unconscious state with lolling tongue and laboured breathing. Although cats may display a similar response they are more likely to seek out a quiet place and rest. They progressively become more lethargic until death or recovery.

RED BELLY BLACK SNAKE BITES IN DOGS

This snake bite can slowly kill but is normally fatal. The venom causes tissue throughout the body to die. The animals suffers severe drooling, vomiting and progressive paralysis, bloody urine as the renal system collapses. This particular snake is not very aggressive and normally will try and bluff its way out of trouble. It is normally found in water ways and marshy area's.



FIRST AID FOR SNAKE BITE IN DOGS

Treat as best you can. The best solution to a dog bitten by a venomous snake is antivenom and vet care. The farther you have to travel to the vet's and the more venom that has been injected into your dog, the worse your dog's chances of survival. However, you and a helper can help prolong your dog's chances of survival by some basic treatment, especially during the car trip to the vet's:

- * Apply a pressure bandage to a limb bite; do not apply a tourniquet or bandage the wound too tightly, as the blood flow must not be impeded. Do not wash the bite area or cut the wound.
- * Apply hand pressure to a body bite (face and jaws are quite common areas for dogs to be bitten)
- * Keep talking to your dog and stroking it; it is good for both of you to feel a sense of reassurance and to keep calm
- * Carry your dog at all times - the dog cannot be expected to walk and any movement will spread the venom.

Venom travels through the lymphatic system and not the blood system so don't be tempted to use the old husbands tale of 'bleeding;' your dog.

VET TREATMENT

Your vet will attempt to ascertain what species of snake bit your dog and treat with either an antivenom or with just IV fluids and sedation. Either way expect recovery in 24 to 48 hours.

DISCOURAGING SNAKES

Many old husbands tales abound about how to keep snakes out of our yards, but really it is common sense. Keep all grass short and do not leave piles of wood, rubbish or iron laying around for snakes to burrow in.

Bird netting used to place over fruit trees is excellent in placing around the bottom of fencing. Snakes cannot get through it and are often found tangled within it.

Ultrasonic snake deterrents, the jury is out on their effectiveness but some swear by them.

An old and proven deterrent is using a pheyinol based cleaner such as wheelie bin cleaner and using it undiluted around the perimeter of your yard, it is said to smell like a pheromone that snakes find distasteful. You will need to top it up every couple of months, it is very cheap and is found in supermarkets .

Dont leave large amounts of water around such as wading pools or the popular shell pools, as snakes will be drawn to them to drink.

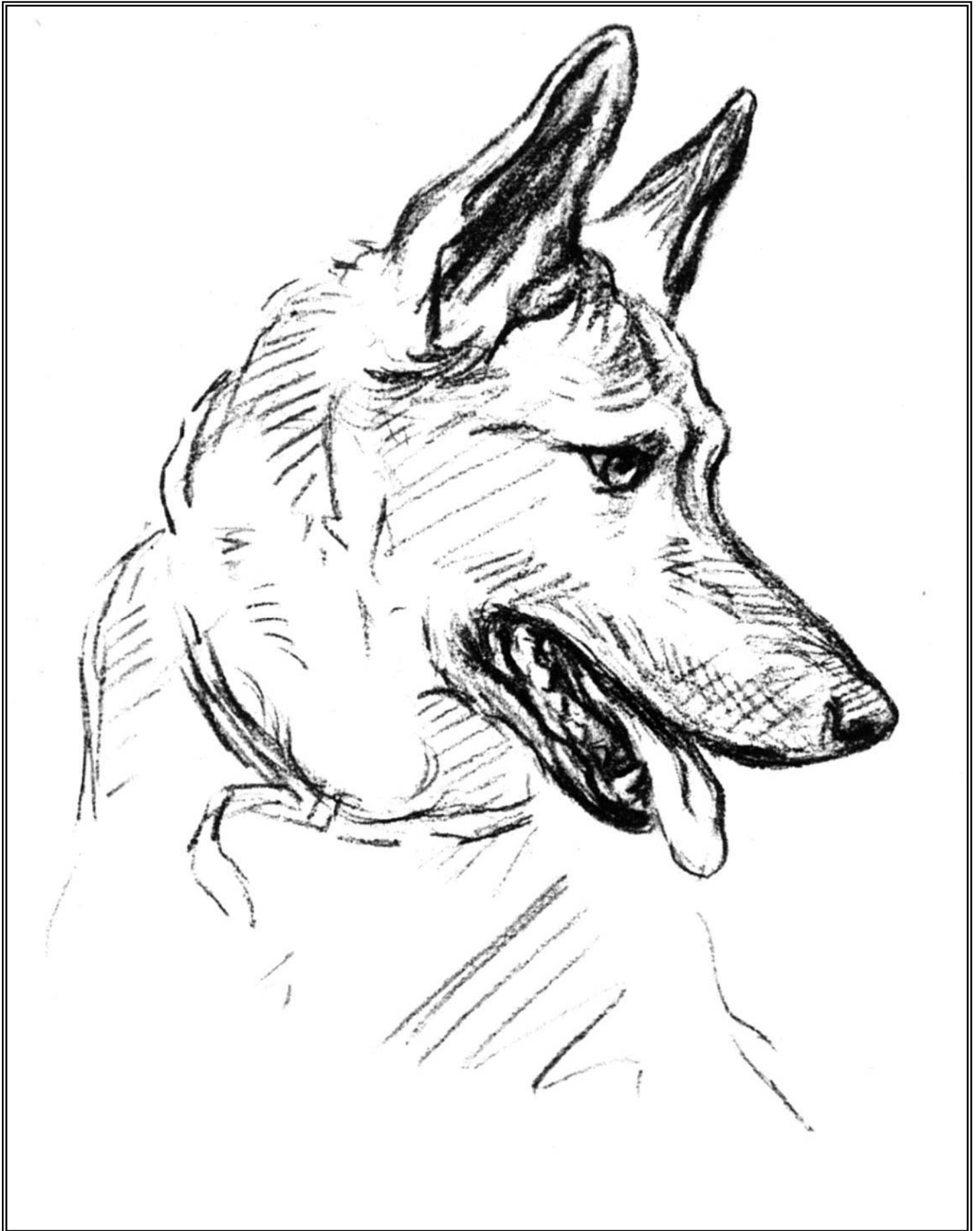

FAMOUS GERMAN SHEPHERDS

RIN TIN TIN

The original Rin Tin Tin served as a Red Cross Dog during WWI with his owner Duncan. Rin Tin Tin made 26 pictures for Warner Brothers before his death on August 10, 1932. At the peak of his career with Warner Brothers he received some 10,000 fan letters a week and was considered to be one of Hollywood's top stars.

Rin Tin Tin II would sire Rin Tin Tin IV, and both dogs were used in the filming of The Adventures of Rin Tin Tin, which first aired on ABC 1954-1959. The first episode of this canine crime fighter series commenced when the U.S. Cavalry came upon a wagon train that had been attacked by Apache Indians.

The only survivors were a young boy named Rusty and his German shepherd he called Rin Tin Tin. The Cavalry took the boy and his dog to Fort Apache in Arizona, where Lt. Ripley "Rip" Masters made Rusty a Corporal so he could stay on at the fort.



THE LITTLEST HOBO

The Littlest Hobo, starring a dog called London, was originally created by Dorrell McGowen for a television movie in 1958.

Following the huge success of the movie, a television series was filmed in black and white between 1963 and 1965, with a total of 65 episodes. In every episode the dog arrived in a new place, made new friends, solved their problems, then left. The series was remade in 1979 and became a family favorite for years to come.

HEROIC GERMAN SHEPHERDS

Bruno

1995

Brooklyn, Newfoundland. Bruno, a nine-month-old German Shepherd saved the life of eleven-year-old Donnie Skiffington when he was thrown from his bicycle into a ditch, where he lay unconscious and bleeding severely. Bruno licked Donnie's face until he regained consciousness, and began to pull him by the shirt collar towards home.

HEROIC GERMAN SHEPHERDS CONTINUED

Nellie

1994

Vienna, Ontario. Nellie, a six-year-old German Shepherd traveled three kilometres back to her home to get help for 78-year-old Ken Emerson, who lay injured after his tractor had overturned and crushed his pelvis. When Nellie returned home, Mrs. Emerson realized that the strip of her husband's shirt wrapped around Nellie's collar was an S.O.S. message, and immediately sent for help.

Brit

Brit won many awards such as the Apprehension Citation in 1997 from the Saddle River P.B.A., the Unit Citation in 1995 by the Waldwick Police Chief, the Certificate of Recognition in 1994 by the Allendale and Waldwick P.B.A. for burglar apprehension, the Exceptional Duty Award in 1998 by the Allendale and Waldwick P.B.A., and the Support Services Award by the Ho-Ho-Kus P.B.A. On October 6, 1997, "Brit" died and was given a full police funeral. On October 21, 1998, Sgt. Litchult received a posthumous K-9 Service Award for K-9 "Brit" from the American Police Hall of Fame & Museum in Miami, Florida.

Sam

1994

Mississauga, Ontario. Sam, an eight-year-old German Shepherd saved her owner, Phyllis McLeod, from drowning when she fell through a frozen river. As Phyllis fought the swift current, she grabbed Sam's collar and hung on until she was pulled far enough out of the water to scramble to safety.

Hustler

1992

Mirror, Alberta. Hustler, a three-year-old German Shepherd is credited with saving the life of his owner, Debbie Inions. After a fall from her horse left Debbie seriously injured and unable to move, Hustler repeatedly fought against vicious attacks by two preying coyotes until they were discovered nine hours later.

Maude

1983

GROUND RULES

These rules apply to all handlers during training sessions and have been formulated for the welfare of you and your dog.

Any Club member or person guilty of unseemly conduct or acts harmful to the Club, may be asked to leave the Training area. They may also be dealt with by the Executive Committee under **Clause 6** and relative by-laws of the Club Constitution.

Any dog which is sick **WILL NOT** be permitted onto the Club Grounds. Dogs who have suffered a **CONTAGIOUS DISEASE WILL NOT** be allowed onto the Club Grounds until 5 weeks after being cleared by a **VETERINARIAN** (a VET Certificate will be required). Puppies should not be brought out onto the Club Grounds under the age of 8 weeks or at least 2 weeks after they have been inoculated for **HEPATITIS, DISTEMPER and PARVOVIRUS**. Vaccination certificate will be required.

The Owner and/or Handler takes responsibility for their dogs while on Club Grounds and must accept liability for animals in their care at all times.

Bitches in season are not permitted on the Club Grounds.

The use of switches, spiked collars or whips is strictly forbidden on the Club Grounds.

Members shall not treat their dog in a manner which may reflect badly on the Club.

Dogs are not to be taken off-lead or left unattended, except on the directives or supervision of a Class Instructor.

The handlers of dogs which foul the Club Grounds will be responsible for cleaning up same with equipment provided.

The Head Instructor has the authority to permit the use of a muzzle or knobbed collar in special cases. The use of this equipment is to be under supervision and its use on the Grounds other than above is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**.

Dogs under the age of 12 months **ARE NOT** permitted to use jump equipment higher than 400mm or longer than 800mm.

Pursuant to the Health Act '**DOGS**' **ARE NOT** permitted inside the Club Rooms.

In the interest of safety and health and in consideration of others, parents are required to supervise the behaviour of their children. The Club Rooms and Toilets **MUST NOT** be used as playing areas.

In the interest of public health the Club Rooms and Veranda are NON-SMOKING areas.
